



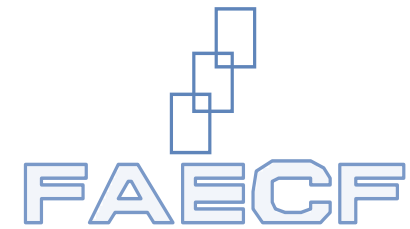

- FAECF maintains close relations with the EC Commission in order to be updated on issues associated with construction legislation or standardization on behalf of its membership, inform on environmental questions and make comments.
- Among the tasks of FAECF is management of international relations as well as preparation of standards and guidelines in cooperation with other professional bodies and associations.
- Activities are also harmonized with overseas partners on the basis of cooperative agreements concluded with the corresponding trade associations JSMA in Japan and AAMA in the USA.
- Furthermore, FAECF has concluded a cooperative agreement with the European material-related association EPW and FEMIB, to set up EuroWindow, an effective grouping to safeguard their interests.
- Via its Technical Commission, FAECF is involved in European and international standardization work

About Eurowindoor

EuroWindoor - a tool to bundle the activities of the European window and door industries

Window, curtain wall and door industries are assuming increasing importance. Many issues which used to be discussed at the national level, need to be reconsidered from an international point of view. The tasks to be covered by trade associations now include management of international relations and preparation of standards and guidelines in cooperation with other professional bodies. Thus, the logical consequence for federations is to enter into cooperations.

Therefore, FAECF (Federation of the European Window and Curtain Wall Associations), representing the aluminium and metal construction sector, FEMIB (Federation of the European Associations for Building Joinery) for the wood sector, EPW, the Federation of the European Plastic Window and Door Manufacturers and agreed to set up EuroWindoor, a powerful cooperation aimed at promoting their interests, on the occasion of the BAU 99 construction fair in Munich on 21 January 1999. UEMV (European Glaziers Association) joined Eurowindoor on 2004.

The main tasks of EuroWindoor are lobbying and supply of information. The cooperation aims to finalize European standardization, prevent unilateral decisions and resolutions taken by national authorities in single-handed attempts, and remove superfluous bureaucracy.
